The future with Wi-Fi 7E

The latest iteration of Wi-Fi technology is commonly called Wi-Fi 7E.

This level of wireless technology is designed to provide users with a significant boost in bandwidth by expanding Wi-Fi into the 7 GHz frequency.

The previous Wi-Fi 7 technology substantially reduced latency, but with Wi-Fi 7E, it's possible for users to take advantage of a whole host of new interactive bandwidth-intensive applications, such as 16K video and virtual and augmented reality.
